## Game Directions for Fortune Keepers

## Setup:

Prepare the fortunes by cutting them out, folding them in half, and placing them in a container. Players gather around in a comfortable setting.

## How to Play:

Draw and Decide: Each player takes turns drawing a fortune from the container. They read it silently and decide whether to keep it or put it back for a chance at a different one.

## Second Chance:

If a player chooses to put a fortune back, they draw again, but this time they must keep the second one they pick.

## In or Out:

Once a player decides to keep a fortune, they are temporarily 'out' of the game, observing the rest of the draws.

## Final Round for Swaps:

After everyone has drawn, there's one final round where players can offer to swap fortunes with each other. Swaps are completely optional and can be accepted or declined.

## The Big Reveal:

Finally, each player reads their fortune aloud and, if they wish, can share why they chose to keep or swap for it.

## Key Points:

Engagement Throughout: Even players who are 'out' after choosing their fortune stay engaged by watching others and participating in the final swap round. One Swap Per Person: To keep it simple, each player can initiate only one swap in the final round. No Eliminations: Everyone ends up with a fortune, ensuring all players are involved until the end.

## Winning:
