

Detailed Route with Campground Directions

****Getting to Atlanta Marietta RV Resort

This is just a general starting point, you can start from elsewhere but here are basic directions for you for reference.

- Starting from Atlanta Airport (for reference):
 - Head east on North Terminal Parkway.
 - Merge onto I-85 N via the ramp to I-20/I-75 N/Atlanta.
 - Take exit 259B for I-285 W toward Birmingham/Tampa.
 - Merge onto I-285 W.
 - Take exit 20 for I-75 N toward Marietta/Chattanooga.
 - Keep left at the fork to continue on Exit 261, and follow signs for GA-280/South Cobb Drive.
 - Use the right lane to merge onto GA-280 N/S Cobb Dr.
 - Turn right onto Highlands Parkway SE.
 - Turn right onto Cobb Parkway SE/US-41 N/US-41 N/US-41 S, and continue to follow US-41 N/US-41 S.
 - The Atlanta Marietta RV Resort will be on your right.

1. Atlanta to Stone Mountain Park

- Starting Point: Atlanta Marietta RV Resort, Atlanta.
- Take I-75 S towards Atlanta.
- Merge onto I-285 E towards Augusta.
- Take Exit 39B to merge onto US-78 E toward Snellville/Athens.
- Follow signs to Stone Mountain Park Campground.

2. Stone Mountain Park to Athens

- Starting Point: Stone Mountain Park Campground.
- Head back to US-78 E towards Athens.
- Continue on US-78 E for about 40 miles.
- In Athens, turn onto Barnett Shoals Rd to Pine Lake Campground.

3. Athens to Savannah

- Starting Point: Pine Lake Campground, Athens.
- Head south on US-129/US-441.
- Merge onto I-16 E towards Savannah.
- Take exit 162 to merge onto US-17 N.
- Continue to Savannah Oaks RV Resort.

4. Savannah to Tybee Island

- Starting Point: Savannah Oaks RV Resort.
- Take US-17 N back to US-80 E towards Tybee Island.
- Stay on US-80 E to reach River's End Campground.

5. Tybee Island to Macon

- Starting Point: River's End Campground, Tybee Island.
- Head west on US-80 W to merge onto I-16 W towards Macon.
- In Macon, take exit 2 for US-80 W.
- Follow signs to Lake Tobesofkee Claystone Park.

6. Macon to Callaway Gardens

- Starting Point: Lake Tobesofkee Claystone Park, Macon.
- Head north on I-475 N.
- Merge onto I-85 N towards Atlanta.
- Take exit 21 towards Pine Mountain.
- Follow signs to Pine Mountain RV Resort near Callaway Gardens.

7. Callaway Gardens to Columbus

- Starting Point: Pine Mountain RV Resort.
- Take GA-354 W to US-27 S towards Columbus.
- In Columbus, take exit 1 for Victory Dr.
- Proceed to Lake Pines RV Park & Campground.

8. Columbus to Dahlonega

- Starting Point: Lake Pines RV Park & Campground, Columbus.
- Head on US-80 E.
- Merge onto I-185 N towards Atlanta.
- Continue on I-85 N.
- Take exit 113 for US-129 N towards Gainesville.
- Continue to Etowah River Campground in Dahlonega.

9. Dahlonega to the Blue Ridge Mountains

- Starting Point: Etowah River Campground, Dahlonega.
- Take US-19 N towards Blue Ridge.
- Continue on GA-60 N.
- In Blue Ridge, turn onto Windy Ridge Rd.
- Arrive at Blue Ridge Mineral Springs RV Park.

10. The Blue Ridge Mountains to Atlanta - Homeward Bound

- Starting Point: Blue Ridge Mineral Springs RV Park.
- Take time to explore the majestic Blue Ridge Mountains, including the Appalachian Trail and the charming town of Blue Ridge.
- When ready to head home, start from the Blue Ridge Mineral Springs RV Park.
- Enter your home address in your GPS.
- For a general route back to Atlanta:
 - Head south on GA-60 to US-76 W.
 - Merge onto I-575 S which becomes I-75 S towards Atlanta.
- Arrive back in Atlanta, filled with unforgettable memories and stories to share.
